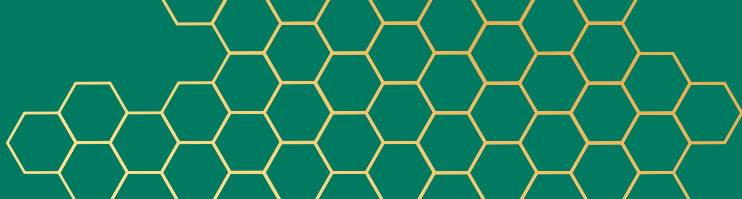

TITLE Women beekeepers as drivers of positive change in Northern Macedonia

MAIN GOAL Economically empowered 50 women from the North-Eastern and Vardar regions of North Macedonia through organic beekeeping

DURATION 15 April 2023 - 15 October 2025





The project achieves its goals through

- **Organic Beekeeping:** 50 families (mainly women and young people) are educated and practically engaged
- **Apiaries:** 25 apiaries established and 25 existing ones are fortified for extreme conditions
- **Women Entrepreneurship:** Empowered 50 women in the production, sales and marketing of bee-related products.
- **Honey Park:** A pilot project to establish an educational tool to promote women entrepreneurship in the area of organic beekeeping, also contributing to the establishment of green infrastructure.
- **Public Awareness Raising:** Learning about the importance and contribution of organic beekeeping to the economic empowerment of women, environmental protection and the achievement of Sustainable Development Goals.

The realisation of the project leads to rural development and the localisation of food production through the independent implementation of organic beekeeping. It also contributes to reducing migration away from rural villages, by creating new opportunities for women, and encouraging young people into new forms of employment.
